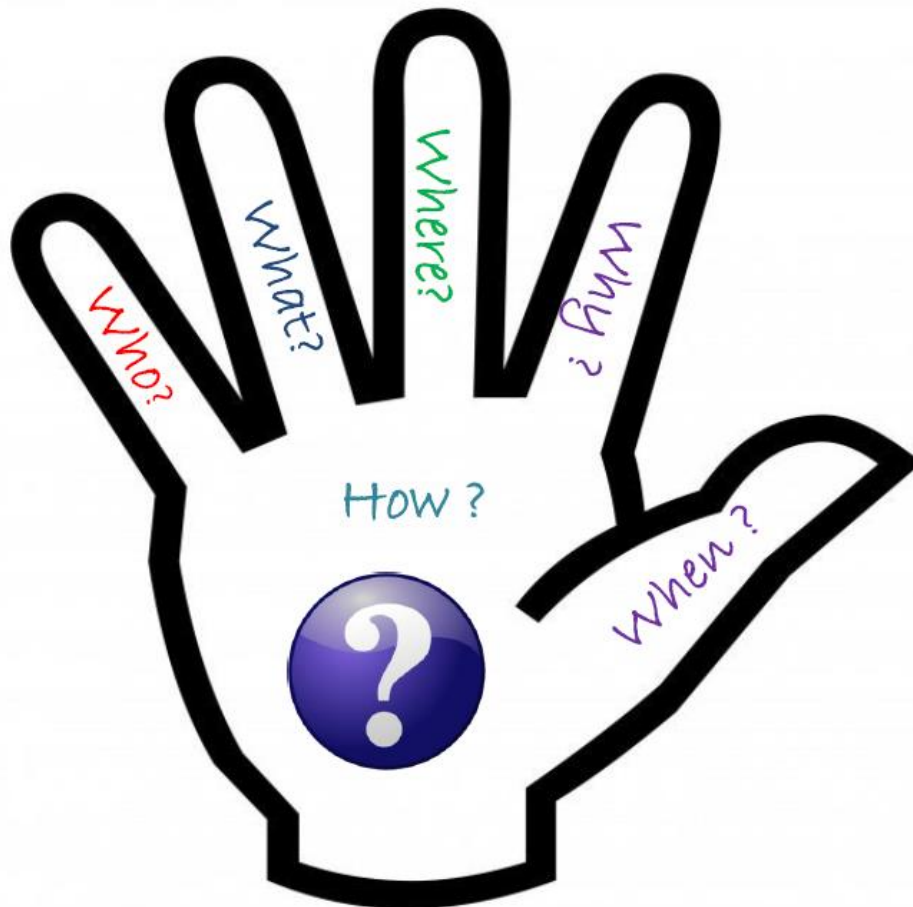

## Task 1 - Talk to the hand!


Pick a character from your book.

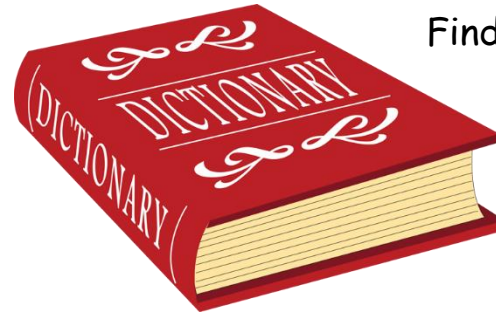
Make a prediction about what will happen next in your book. Use evidence from the book so far to support your ideas.
