


Warm up Task

I can find a half of an amount

Mrs Beazley's dog, Chewy, had 10 biscuits. He was allowed to eat half of them.
How many did he eat?



Chewy had 6 toys. He lost half $\frac{1}{2}$ of them. How many did he have left to play with?

Helpful Hint

Count out the counters or draw the objects

Put them into 2 equal halves. How many are in each half? That is how many he can have.

I can find a quarter of an amount

Mrs Beazley's dog, Chewy, had 12 biscuits. He was allowed to eat a quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of them.
How many did he eat?

Chewy had 20 toys. He lost a quarter of them. How many did he have left to play with?
What would two quarters $\frac{2}{4}$ be?

Helpful Hint

Put the objects into 4 equal groups and see what is in each group. Can you remember how to draw a bar model or count in groups of 4 on a number line?
